

These masks were made with love and good intentions - made from 100% cotton. These **do not** provide the same level of protection as N95 masks but **DO** act as a barrier to sharing or receiving the virus. Pinch nose piece and secure mask tightly over your mouth and nose.

Please sanitize again by washing in hot water before wearing and after each use when worn in public. Remove and handle as if the mask is infected – carefully remove, place in plastic bag and wash immediately- hot water and dryer before wearing again. Then WASH YOUR HANDS☺

There is a pocket on the bottom to add a removable filter. You can cut a HEPA cloth vacuum filter, a Swiffer duster, non-woven interfacing or polypropylene fabric such as some reusable grocery bags. Even a paper towel will provide some extra protection. Remove before washing and replace.
